Charitable fund gifts are processed differently than regular cash gifts. Pledges will show as unpaid from the donor if payment was received though a charitable fund. Please contact us at the Office of Stewardship 404-920-7600 to receive donor information/details from the charitable fund.

Year End

To be included in the 2019 individual tax statements, the Internal Revenue Service requires that parishioner gifts and pledge payments to the 2019 Archbishop's Annual Appeal, whether mailed directly by the individual or forwarded by the parish via UPS or FedEx, must be postmarked by December 31, 2019.

December 31 Falls on Tuesday, remember that all Appeal gifts should no longer be forwarded to Agilis. All gifts should now go directly to the new address. Gifts mailed after that date, though still applicable to the 2019 goal/rebate purposes, will NOT be reflected on 2019 individual tax statements.

To meet the IRS deadline, please encourage parishioner's to make yearendgifts to the Appeal online (donate.archatl.com) or mail their payments as they would any other year-end charitable gift by December 31, directly to:

Stewardship Saint of the Month: December




Saint John of Kanty

John of Kanty, also known as John Cantius, was born to a wealthy family in Kanti, near Auschwitz, Poland, in 1390. He was educated at the University of Krakow and was ordained a priest soon after completing his studies. John was appointed a lecturer at the university and was known to be an effective teacher and preacher. He was assigned to a parish for a time, but after a few years was recalled to university life to hold a chair in theology.
