#### Announcement Weekend, February 16 - 17, 2019

The focus of announcement weekend is to provide substantial information about the use of Annual Appeal funds and to advise parishioners that they will be asked to give the following week during the in-pew process (on Commitment Weekend).

- Put up posters, prayer cards and brochures
- Insert Bulletin Announcements <u>English</u> and <u>Spanish</u> for Archbishop's Annual Appeal in your Parish Bulletin
- Include the campaign in the Prayers of the Faithful <u>English</u> and <u>Spanish</u>.
- Prepare the Homily
  - The homily should be a five to seven minute presentation.
  - The homily should serve as a prelude to the Archbishop's recorded homily, which will be played on February 23-24.
  - Use the Sample Homily in your Training Manual to assist pastors as they prepare their homilies (page 15 in the Training Manual).
    - It's important to include the following information:
      - The Archbishop's Annual Appeal is not another special collection, but rather the one time during the year that all Catholics are asked to make a significant pledge, payable over ten months to our Archdiocese so that it can meet the spiritual, educational and temporal needs of parishes, schools and the people throughout the Archdiocese.
      - Inform parishioners that the following week (on Commitment Weekend) they will hear a message, via recorded homily, from the Archbishop himself.
      - Ask parishioners to read the campaign information that they will receive in the bulletin.

- Ask them to donate to the Archbishop's Annual Appeal and to prayerfully reflect on the amount of their pledge.
- Share the theme of the appeal "Go, Therefore and Make Disciples."
- Mention how the parish will use any rebates it may receive.
- Mention the programs funded by the Appeal (see page 18 in Training Manual).

#### What do I need to do on Commitment Weekend?

Here are some ways you can prepare for Commitment Weekend.

- Prepare volunteers to distribute and collect in-pew envelopes and pencils at each Mass.
- 2. Pastors or designated person to guide parishioners though the in-pew process.
- 3. DVD or CD Homily should be prepared and ready to play during the Homily. If your DVD is not working <u>click here</u> for a list of video links. You can also find this document in <u>Parish Tools</u>.
- 4. Prayers of the Faithful.
- 5. Have someone available to answer questions after Mass.
- 6. Poster, brochures should be visible in key areas of the Parish.
- 7. Prayer cards should be available in key areas of the Parish.
- 8. Bulletin announcements for Commitment Weekend and Follow-Up Weekend.

#### Materials Needed:

- In-Pew envelopes and pencils
- Script (see training manual)
- Brochures (English and Spanish) place in the pews or a visible area in the Parish
- Posters (English and Spanish) digital format available in Parish Tools.
- Training Manual (English and Spanish are in the same manual).

- In-pew envelopes and pencils
- Script (see training manual)
- Posters, brochures, prayer cards
- Training Manual




#### Oración de Corresponsabilidad
