The USCCB Committee on Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth highlights various resources for National Marriage Week (February 7th-14th) that may be of assistance to you and your parish.

Preaching Resource – Based on the readings for World Marriage Day, Sunday, February 14th. This <u>preaching resource</u> has a suggested emphasis on marriage and mercy this year.

Bulletin Insert – This insert utilizes social science data to highlight marriage as a great good in itself and as a gift to the married couple, their children and society. It is available in <u>color</u> and <u>black and white</u>.

Virtual Marriage Retreat – This is the second annual online seven-day retreat for married couples during National Marriage Week. This year's theme is "Marriage and Mercy." Last year, 1,030 people participated in the retreat this way!
