Brothers, I personally encourage you to celebrate this solemnity in this Jubilee Year with even more joy and hearts filled with gratitude for the gift of God himself to us. I invite you to plan local events during and around the celebration of the Solemnity of Corpus Christi in 2025.

Consider organizing a **local Eucharistic procession** on parish property or beyond and celebrating a **holy hour for the intention of a Eucharistic revival in our archdiocese**.
