



"In His Footsteps" Pilgrimage Itinerary Highlights January 10 – 18, 2022

Day 1:

Departure from USA

Depart for your overnight flights to the Holy Land.

Day 2:

Arrive Tel Aviv, Transfer to Tiberius, Nazareth

Arrive in Tel Aviv in the AM, meet your guide and transfer to Tiberius via coastal plains

Day 3:

Caesarea Philippi, Sea of Galilee

- Caesarea Philippi.
- Tabgha, site of the multiplication of the fishes and the loaves
- The Mount of Beatitudes for a time of prayer and reflection.
- St. Peter's Primacy. Capernaum. Enjoy a meal of "St. Peter's fish" and boat ride on the Sea of Galilee.
- Dinner and overnight at hotel in Tiberius.

Day 4:

Nazareth, Mount Carmel.

- Cana of Galilee. Nazareth, visiting the Basilica of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Church, and Mary's well.
- Drive to city of Haifa, Mount Carmel, visit church of Prophet Elijah.
- Visit Caesarea Maritima.
- Dinner and overnight at hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 5:

Bethlehem, Dead Sea.

- Old city of Bethlehem. The Church of the Nativity. Shepherd's Field in Beit Sahour.
- River Jordan, Qumran, site of the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls
- Visit Jericho, Zacchaeus tree old city and view mount of Temptation.
- If time permits, we will enjoy a float in the Dead Sea
- Dinner and overnight at hotel in Bethlehem.

Day 6:

Mt of Olives, Gethsemane Mt. Zion

- Depart Bethlehem to Jerusalem
- Panoramic view from the top of Mount of Olives.
- Ascension Hill on the Mount of Olives. The Church of Pater Noster. The Church of Dominus Flevit.
- The Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations.
- Mt. Zion and the Cenacle (Upper Room).
- Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 7:

Old City Jerusalem

- The Western Wall and the Temple Mount, view of the Dome of the Rock and El-Aqsa Mosque.
- St. Anne's Church, the Pools of Bethesda.
- Walk the Via Dolorosa ending at the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Ein Karem.
- Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 8:

Bethlehem

- Meet with the local Christian leaders
- We will enjoy a free day for reflection and celebration.
- Dinner and overnight in Bethlehem.

Day 9:

Departure

We will arrive back in the USA the same day

Day 9:

Arrival/Athens Sightseeing Tour (D)

The trip will start with your arrival in Athens airport where we will meet and transfer to Athens city center for Athens Sightseeing Tour. Athens is one of the most glorious cities in the world and the cradle of western civilization as we know it today. We will visit the main points of interest in the city: the Acropolis, the Parthenon and Mars' Hill (Areopagus) where Paul preached the truth to the Gentle Natio. Tour ends with transfer to hotel for check in dinner & overnight.

Day 10:

Athens / Kalambaka (B/L/D)

After breakfast the trip continues with a visit the spectacular Meteora, the UNESCO World Heritage Site, which is a mountainous region of stunning scenery. You will see hundred-year-old Byzantine monasteries on top of huge rocks, during the middle Ages, first built in the 14th century by monks seeking isolation and salvation. We will visit two of the most famous of them, which is now a popular museum, the Great Meteoron, & Varlaam to admire superb icons, old manuscripts, unique mosaics and frescoes. We will drive you to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 11:

Kalambaka/ Veria / Vergina/Thessaloniki (B/L/D)

After breakfast the trip continues with stop in Veria (Berea), a town evangelized by Paul (Acts 17: 10-14). When Saint Paul visited this town in AD50, he came across a more "noble" Jewish community where he preached and created an important Church. This is where Paul met Sopatros (or Sosipatros), who would later become a valuable comrade who followed him on his return journey to Asia. We will visit the ancient synagogue where we will see the Byzantine mosaic in the monument commemorating his preaching. Then we will head to Vergina, the legendary burial site of the Macedonian kings. This place is considered as a World Heritage Site, also known as the Royal Tombs and houses the tomb of King Philip II, father of Alexander the Great. We will drive you to Thessaloniki for dinner and overnight.

Day 12:

Thessaloniki / Philippi / Kavala /Thessaloniki (B/L/D)

Breakfast and trip to Philippi, the town where Paul delivered his first sermon in Europe, sowing the seeds of Christianity. "And from there (He went) to Philippi, which is the leading city of the district of Macedonia and a Roman Colony. We remained in this city some days..." (Acts 16:11-12). Paul arrived here with Silas and Luke on the winter of AD 49 to AD50. There the first Christian baptism was performed, of a woman named Lydia. Although they were prosecuted and arrested, they received God's help to escape from prison (Acts 16: 25-26) where there was the conversion of the jailer (Acts 16: 31). We will visit the Roman Theatre, probable site of the prison where Paul and Silas were arrested. We will continue towards the city of Kavala, the ancient city of Neapolis (Acts 16:11) where Paul landed with his disciples, Timothy and Silas. It was later renamed Christoupolis, meaning city of Christ, because it was the first European city to accept Christianity. We will visit the Roman Aqueduct and the ruins of the Acropolis. Dinner and overnight in Thessaloniki.

Day 13:

Thessaloniki / Athens (B/L/D)

After breakfast the trip continues with exploring the city of Thessalonica, where Paul preached the gospel in the second and third missionary journey. For the early Christians of this city he wrote epistles "To the Thessalonians.". We will visit the Cathedral of St. Demetrius, the Protector Saint of the city, the Church of Saint Sofia, the great Church of Saint George which is hosted in a medieval building, the Byzantine temple of "Panagia Chalkeon", the historical Church of Prophet Elias, the White Tower and the Byzantine fortress of the city. Return to Athens in the afternoon dinner & Overnight in Athens

Day 14:

Athens / Ancient Corinth Cenchrea / Departure (B)

Early breakfast at hotel

We will head toward ancient Corinth (Acts 18.1-18). It was in ancient Corinth where Paul came and worked, established a thriving church and writing two of the epistles, which are now part of the New Testament. We will see all the sites that are associated with his ministry: the Agora, the Temple of Apollo, the roman Odeon, the Bema and Gallio's seat, the pillars, stairs, and the place of public worship, where Paul preached. All these visits will certainly enhance the understanding of Corinthians I and II. Before ending the tour and return to Athens, we will visit the ancient Greek port of Cenchrea (Acts 18:18) where Paul was during his second missionary journey and the ruin of the early Christian 5th Century basilica. We will drive back to Athens Airport for departure flight back home.

Note: While we do our very best at making sure all items listed in your itinerary are included, there are times when conditions beyond our control affect your program/itinerary, including but not limited to air carrier changes, delays, weather, political climate, time constraints, or changes by your tour leader and tour guide.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$250.00 per person is required to make a reservation. The final payment is due no less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour (October 10, 2021). Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments will only be accepted for the full price of the tour cost at the time of booking. Reservations received after October 10, 2021 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of \$100.00 per person to cover administrative and communication costs up until 121 days before departure.
