#### First Communicants

The First Communicants will NOT be participating in the morning procession this year.

First Communicants will participate in the procession on Saturday, June 22nd *in the afternoon.* Children should wear their First Communion attire and be dropped off by a parent or guardian in the hallway between Hall A and the Spanish Suite at 4:30-4:55 p.m. More information <u>here</u>.

## Children's Track

The Children's Track is open to children ages 5 to 10 years old who have a parent attending the Eucharistic Congress. Space is limited and available based on the number of child to volunteer ratio. There is no cost to participate.
