





## Holy Land Pilgrimage

## Familiarization Pilgrimage for EO Catholic Hosts & Clergy

#### January 23 & 24 - USA to the Holy Land

Your spiritual pilgrimage begins as you depart the USA on an overnight flight. You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our airport representative and transferred to your Jerusalem hotel. Enjoy dinner before retiring for the night.

### January 25 - Jericho & Bethlehem

Journey to Jericho (considered the oldest city in the world). In the distance you can see the traditional site of the Temptation of Jesus (Matt.4:1). Stop briefly at a large Sycamore tree and recall Jesus' invitation to Zacchaeus. Visit Qasr-el-Yehud and renew your own baptismal vows at the Jordan River where Jesus was baptized by John. In Bethlehem, visit the cave revered as Jesus' birthplace which now resides in the world's oldest functioning church (Matt. 1:18-25). Celebrate Mass in St. Catherine's Church and gaze out over Shepherds' Field, where the angels first proclaimed the Good News.

### January 26 - Ein Karem, Emmaus & Nazareth

Travel to Ein Karem, the village where John the Baptist was born and the Virgin Mary visited Elizabeth prior to our Lord's birth (Luke 1:26-40). See the Church of St. John, birthplace of John the Baptist, and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Visitation. During a short stop in Emmaus, you'll see the traditional site where Jesus appeared to two disciples after His resurrection. After lunch, we'll journey north to Cana where Jesus performed his first miracle (John 2:1-12) then continue on to Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matt. 2:23) where we will visit the Church of the Annunciation.

## January 27 - The Galilee

Enjoy beautiful Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry, and visit the synagogue located on the site where Jesus taught (Matt.4:13, 23). Sail across the Sea of Galilee and experience a special onboard worship service. On the Mount of Beatitudes (Matt. 5-7), listen to Jesus's Sermon on the Mount, and celebrate Mass at the Church of the Beatitudes. At Tabgha , traditional location of the feeding of the 5,000, visit the Church of the Fish and the Loaves (Luke 9:10-17). Take a moment to reflect and pray in the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21). Visit the recently excavated village of Mary Magdalene.

#### January 28 - Jerusalem

Be inspired by the breathtaking beauty of Jerusalem ("the Golden City") as you stand on the Mount of Olives, the place from which Jesus ascended into heaven forty days after His resurrection (Acts 1:9-12). Walk the Palm Sunday road with a stop along the way at the Church of Dominus Flavit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem. Celebrate Mass in the Garden of Gethsemane where Jesus prayed before His crucifixion (Matt. 26:36-44). On Mount Zion, see the House of the High Priest Caiaphas, where Jesus was imprisoned the night of His arrest (Matt. 26:57-65). Nearby is the Upper Room revered as the location of the Last Supper (Mark 14:12-26). Conclude your day by visiting the Church of the Dormition of Mary.

#### January 29 - Jerusalem and the Old City

Enter the Old City through St. Steven's Gate where the first martyr and deacon was stoned. View the Pool of Bethesda, where Jesus performed the Sabbath miracle of healing (John 5:1-31), and sing a hymn in the Church of St. Anne, renowned for its beautiful acoustics. At Herod's Antonia Fortress, see where Jesus was brought before Pontius Pilate (Luke 23:1-11). Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross," and celebrate the Mass of the Resurrection at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Visit the Southern Wall Excavations of the Temple, including the Teaching Steps and the Western Wall. Take a leisurely stroll down the Cardo, the main street of the Old City where modern shops stand among ancient ones.

#### January 30 - Return to USA





There is no reimbursement for fewer than 20 passengers. Requests for reimbursements must be made in writing.

#### REGISTRATIONS RECEIVED after October 10, 2017:

We welcome registrations after 10/10/17. Registrations received between 10/11/17 - 10/25/17 will incur a \$100 per person fee. Registrations received between 10/26/17 - 11/09/17 will incur a \$200 per person fee. Registrations received between 11/10/17 - 11/24/17 will incur a \$400 per person fee. Registrations received on 11/25/17 or later will incur an additional fee based on air availability. Additional fees will be advised upon registration.

100% of Cancellation Fees are covered by the optional Travel Protection Program, provided premium has been paid and reason for cancellation is insurable. Those who do not take travel protection should be aware of the following cancellation penalties: From day of registration to 105 days prior to departure, you will be charged the \$100 nonrefundable administrative fee plus any airline fees.
