Re: Potential cyclone nine, likely Helene

Potential cyclone nine, likely Helene, is projected to have storm impacts on Georgia as a tropical storm with tropical-storm-force winds and heavy rains. Given the size and potential track of this system, there are several potential hazards for our region, including heavy rainfall and flash flooding. River flooding may also occur, especially in low-lying or flood-prone areas. It is possible for strong winds which could lead to downed trees and power lines.

Please take the appropriate measures to protect buildings and secure any outdoor property. Trim back any trees and large shrubs if time allows to make them more wind-resistant and be mindful of where vehicles are parked.
