For the last several years, the archdiocese has provided all priests a group subscription to SLIconnect, an educational initiative of the Saint Luke Institute. SLIconnect is an outstanding online resource providing ongoing formation designed for Catholic clergy by experts in psychological and spiritual health.

Our group subscription gives every priest free access to more than 100 one-hour recorded courses on a wide variety of topics highly relevant to our experience as priests. (Without a subscription, there is a \$25 charge per course.) Membership also permits access to live monthly webinars. Many of our priests have already taken advantage of this subscription and have found that SLIconnect provides practical information for healthy life and ministry.
