Meal Packing Event at the 2020 Eucharistic Congress

2020 marks the 25th Annual Eucharistic Congress!

What better way to celebrate 25 years than to pack 250,000 meals!

Yes, you read that right. We will pack a quarter of a million meals for Starve Wars: Episode V!

In order to reach this goal, our meal packing event has to be bigger than ever before. We will double our Friday morning packing sessions to accommodate 600 packers at *each session*. We will also be offering some exciting opportunities to be involved before our June 12 event if you would like to do more or will not be able to make our June 12 packing.
