The format allows for a more gradual integration of the material and healing process, providing ample time for reading, reflection and journaling between sessions.

Drawing upon the wisdom presented in the book Life-Giving Wounds, the group will focus on fostering a sense of community, providing mutual support and encouragement, exploring themes of healing and reconciliation, and cultivating spiritual growth.

For those unable to attend in person at the Chancery in Smyrna, hybrid meeting options will be available. Our goal is to offer accessible support to all who need it.
