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The morning session of this workshop will explore the development of prayer in the life of children ages 3-12:

- The characteristics of the child at different stages of development
- The needs of the child at each stage and how we may meet them
- How the scripture offers children a language for prayer

- Our role as catechists in communicating sacred history
- Old Testament and Gospel narratives as the foundation of our sacred story
